



Hebe ‘Purple Shamrock’ Neproch EU 9616

truly a Plant for All Seasons

Discovered in the late 1990s by Doug Thompson, as a sport of Hebe ‘Mrs Winder’, this compact hardy variegated Hebe was one of the first of the many variegated winter foliage varieties that are now available to growers and retailers alike. Time however has not lessened interest in this variety, which looks good all year round and is grown widely in Europe as well as on many nurseries in the UK.

During the summer the narrow lime-green leaves are edged yellow and contrast well against the purple stem and young growth before occasional sky-blue flowers add further interest on established plants in late summer.



However, it is during the winter and early spring that this plant really catches the eye, when the foliage turns a stunning deep purple which lasts until the new growth emerges from April onwards.
